The Fondation CIGREF launches its second call for proposals related to the international research programme on *Information Systems*

This call for proposals is the second to be published by the [Information Systems Dynamics](#) (ISD) international research programme; the programme aims at supporting research projects studying the dynamics of information systems use across five dimensions: Strategic, Organisational, Societal & Ethical, Regulatory, and Technological. This second call for proposals approved by the [Scientific Committee](#) concerns five work packages:

- WP n°13 : Blank Project

This call for proposals is open to research institutions (public research institutions, universities, *specialist graduate schools*). International teams are encouraged to participate. This call will open for applications on November 4. The deadline for submitting proposals is January 3 2011.
